- Discussion was revisited on KBARNA's request for Conference Agenda Report (CAR) and Conference Approval Track (CAT) voting policy. It goes back to the groups for discussion and input. The question involves recording the votes as each individual addict, by each home group or tallied y/n votes from individual home group members.
- Regional motion #1-1-21 goes back to the groups: to send \$1500 donation to WSC for COVID-19 impact. V-Chair provided additional clarity on the issue with a noted \$19,000 annual budget, \$1300 prudent reserve, and \$15,000.00 + current balance. The Venmo app was supported over using Cash-App to meet the needs of the ASC. The discussion came up around the policy needed as well to be explored by the V-Chair/lame duck Ad-Hoc P&P Chair.
