

Hello family. I attended the Regional meeting on March, 21. Our Regional Delegate reported that the World Convention is being scheduled to be in Melbourne, Australia in 2022. World expenses were currently at five million dollars and they only had 1.2 million. KRCNA 34 is scheduled to be the weekend of August 27, 28, 29 in Clarksville IN at the Derby Hotel. KRCNA 35 is hoping to be on schedule and fall on Easter weekend of 2022. There were questions about the intent of motion 1-1-21 at the last Area meeting.
