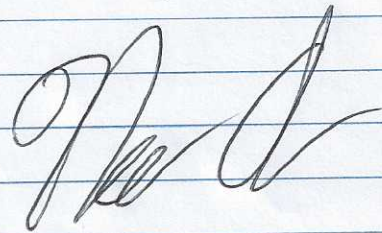

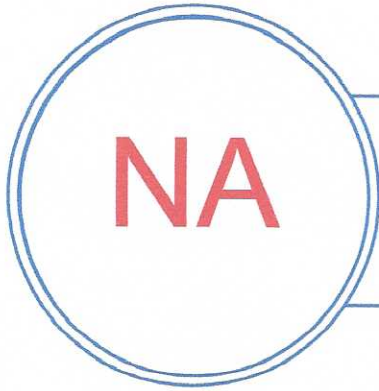

Regional Meeting  
RCMA Report

I attended the regional meeting to represent our area as the RCM was unable to attend.

Discussion was held on the Regional Events liability insurance that KBARNA was reported as having in place. It was reported that some venues are asking for non-profit status or proof of insurance. It was unclear who or what exactly would be covered all groups, the area or regions. This will require further discussion and clarification. The proposed liability policy has been included in the July minutes for the groups to review/discuss. (see attachment) **Motion #7-4-22** goes back to the groups

Select Regional committee members Tony J & Mark S. are exploring the 501C3 option.

The ongoing discussion from last month was held around the regional rotation that was actually voted on and adopted in September 2018 and included in the minutes. It was recorded in the September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018 regional minutes as approved. In oversight, the regional events rotation was not added to the updated regional policy, leaving to question for some who will host the next convention. After doing some research with the support of our former RDA at the time Elizabeth S., it appears that the rotation in our official record of proceedings at region simply needs to be amended to reflect the disruption of rotation due to COVID-19 that took Louisville area 2 years to finally host KRCNA 35 in August of 2021. It is the collective understanding of the former RDA and with my limited understanding that a **motion to amend the current schedule be considered** to account for the year lost due to COVID would show SCKA hosting KRCNA 37 in 2024. This could eliminate the potential confusion going forward. As of right now and with this understanding SCKANA should consider preparing to have our Convention Chair in place for the September 2022 Regional meeting; giving this area the 18 months needed per policy to host KRCNA 37 in Bowling Green, KY.

The KRCNA 36 Chair is Jason J. OVANA.

KRCNA 35 turned in \$12,583.75 to regional treasurer, final report to be given in September

From the discussion mentioned already about the question of regional events rotation, the zonal rotation was presented again by the 502 Area. Several concerns were expressed about the same motion being presented by the same area that was previously voted down in the September 2018; especially when the current regional rotation was voted in but never added/updated into our current regional policy. Concerns were expressed by the acting chair along with another area to consider policy that could prevent a motion can't be presented again by the same area if previously voted down by the regional body. The motion was made again by the 502 area and eventually seconded by OA to go back to the areas. **Motion #7-1-22** goes back to the groups for a vote: to adapt the zonal rotation for KRCNA events hot city would be decided between the areas in each select zone. This would replace the current policy for regional rotation and could potentially impact the regional events schedule beginning 2024.

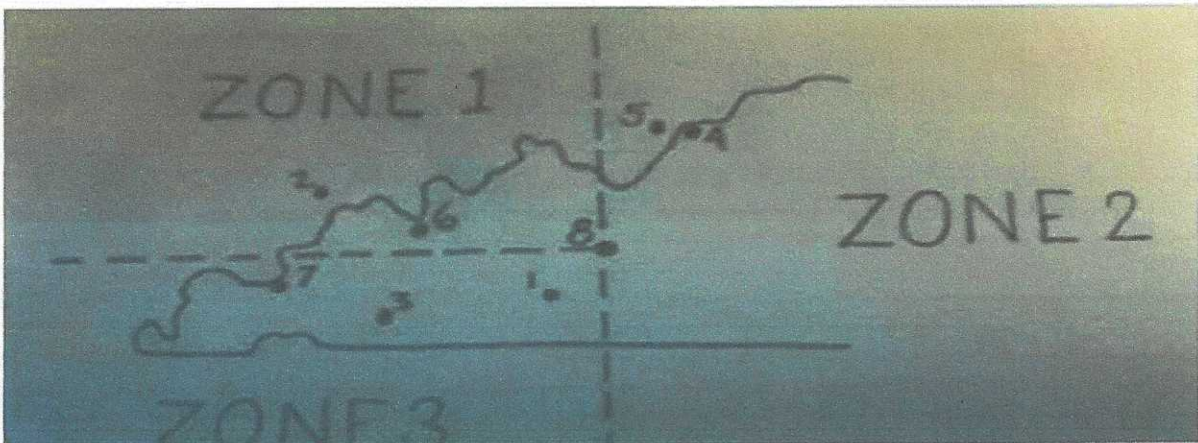
