


Dear Family,

I attended the October 5th rescheduled September regional meeting via zoom.

Executive committee members were present with V-Chair position still vacant and Treasurer acting in a Lamé Duck capacity.

All RCM's were present with the exception of the 502 area.

This marks several consecutive misses and letter of concern was sent out in May, attendance policy was reviewed.

RD and RDA were both absent with no report.

Treasurer's report was given with a reported balance of \$29,822.01 Our insurance event policy is paid up, storage building was paid up for the year at \$720.00, and this includes 10 months of \$10,000 insurance coverage on contents.
