money will go now that there is a metro PR (is this just for the meeting schedules or for all PR work? Where would the money go? To OVANA or to the pooled PR?)


NEW BUSINESS

These two motions (9-3-23 and 9-4-23) were not included in their entirety in the September minutes so Region voted to send them out to Areas for a new vote.

Motion 9-3-23: (ATRANA). The Across the Rivers Area Public Relations group is asking for a budget of \$1675 for a billboard in our area. The production part of the billboard is going to cost a total of \$175 for the vinyl wrap that will be displayed. The \$1500 will be used to pay for a 12 week duration of display. Attached is a breakdown of the options and cost as well as a possible design idea. The vinyl wrap will be ours to keep even after the 12 week period is up so that we can use it for future projects. The intent for the billboard is to carry the message of Narcotics Anonymous to the public. We intend to display our hotline phone number as well as our website to reach as many addicts in need as possible. We plan to carefully watch the traffic on our website and hotline while the billboard is displayed to gauge how effective our public relations campaign with the billboard will be. We believe this will be a great way and the best way for us to reach as many addicts as possible at this time.


