RD Report:

CAR is available on NA.org. CAT will be available on 2/3/26. The upcoming world convention for 2028 is in the planning stages. They are looking at a European location of either Portugal, Germany, or Ireland. Kevin D. reported not having the time or resources to attend the World Service Conference therefore Rodney B. will go in his place. He has agreed to remain in the position and assist with CAR/CAT workshops until the end of his service commitment. He expressed concerns over offering several times to develop a workshop to discuss a policy for KBARNA but has no support for this.

Treasurer requested approval to send \$400 to SZF and this was already in the budget, therefore approved.

Regional chair received a letter from someone in prison from Manchester requesting help. It was determined that BARCNA covers Manchester, and the chair will forward the letter to BARCNA.
